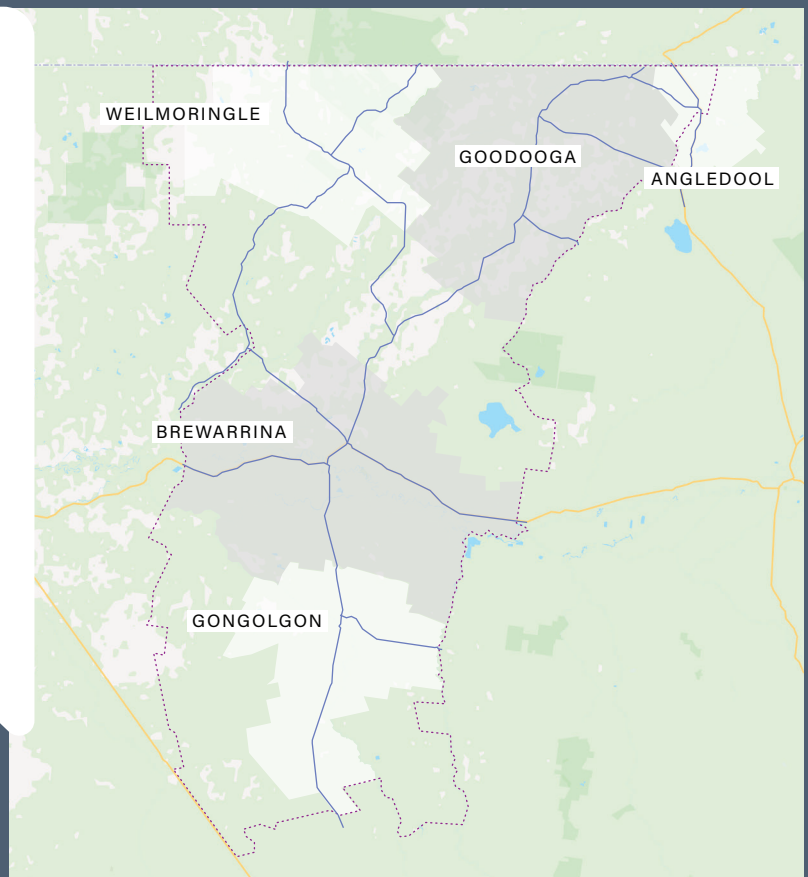
## Frequently Asked Questions
